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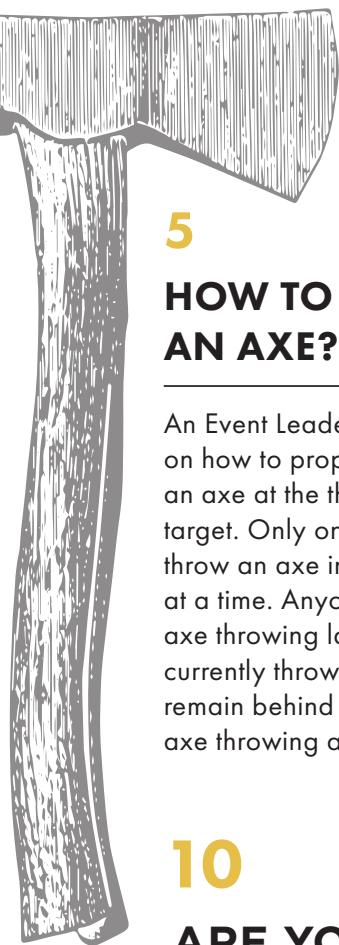
Who can use the throwing lanes?

Throwing lanes are to be used by league members and participants of scheduled events. Prior to throwing an axe, all participants must read the safety and best practices rules, and sign the AXE Throwing Calgary waiver.

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IS THE EVENT LEADER PRESENT?

All AXE throwing leagues and private events are run under the supervision of an Event Leader. Axe throwing is only permitted when an Event Leader is present and actively supervising a throwing lane.



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HOW TO THROW AN AXE?

An Event Leader will instruct you on how to properly throw an axe at the throwing lane target. Only one person may throw an axe in a throwing lane at a time. Anyone present in the axe throwing lane area and not currently throwing the axe must remain behind the designated axe throwing area at all times.

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ARE YOU FOLLOWING THE RULES?

League and private event play follow specific rules to ensure a fun and safe experience. Participants must follow the stated rules and AXE staff instruction.

Is your clothing appropriate?

All competitors must wear appropriate clothing and footwear. A loose fitting top is recommended for comfortable upper body movement. Footwear should have good traction for stability. Closed toed shoes are mandatory.



SAFETY & BEST PRACTICES

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How to hold an axe?

All axes are sharpened to effectively splinter the target. Axes must be held by the wood handle for competitor safety. The axe head should always be held downwards when outside a throwing lane, and never pointed at a fellow competitor.

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HOW TO RETRIEVE AN AXE?

Competitors must wait until both head-to-head opponents throw their axes before retrieving their throws. After both axes are thrown, competitors are permitted to cross the throwing line to retrieve their axe.

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WHERE TO EAT?

No food or drinks are permitted inside the throwing lanes. Food and drink may only be consumed inside designated areas as specified by the Event Leader.

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Are the targets approved?

Use approved targets only. No axe throwing at unspecified objects unless approved by the Event Leader.

ARE YOU THINKING CLEARLY?

No person impaired by alcohol or drugs will be allowed to axe throw. Participation in AXE Throwing Calgary leagues and events is subject to the Event Leader's discretion. AXE staff may ask anyone to stop participating in axe throwing at any time.
